



**TEN ROGUES**


**A VERY STABLE GENIUS**


**FIRE COUNTRY**


**DEAR PARENTS**

At 23, Joshua Wong has already spent a year in detention as a political prisoner. In *Unfree Speech*, he calls for global democratisation.




**WE SWIM TO THE SHARK**






**APEIROGON**


**ACTRESS**


When Cara gets a concussion at a family gathering, she can't keep her thoughts to herself. Secrets start to pour out — with the whole family present to witness.

Winner of the Miles Franklin Prize for her 2013 novel, *All the Birds, Singing*.


A gothic delight that follows the lives of three women across four centuries. From witch trials to widowhood, *The Bass Rock* is biting angry, and undeniably beautiful.


